NCTAE Educator of the Year 2022-2023

**Recognizing Excellence and Service
in Theatre Arts Education**

Criteria for Nominees:

- Member has made a significant contribution to theatre arts education in their local school, their district, and/or the state
- Member for the last 3 years, plus current year's membership dues paid
- Attended at least one NCTAE Conference for each of last two years (Fall Sharing Conference or Winter Focus Conference)

Nomination Process:

Nominations must be submitted by current members. Members may nominate other current members or you may self-nominate. Nominations may be submitted via email or as an attached document to an email. Nominations should include, as a minimum:

- Nominee's name, school name, grade levels taught
- If known by nominator, years of NCTAE membership and participation in Conferences
- Contributions to the nominee's local school theatre arts education program
- Contributions to theatre arts education in the home district; include all district-level leadership, especially in theatre arts education
- Contributions to theatre arts education in the state of North Carolina; include all state-level leadership, especially in theatre arts

Submissions:

- Nominations may be submitted via email or as an attached document to an email
- Nominations should be submitted to Chuck Stowe at president@nctae.com
- **Nominations must be received by 5:00 PM on Friday, September 9, 2022.**

Selection:

Qualified nominations will be shared with the Board for discussion and selection.

Recognition:

All qualified nominees will be recognized during the Fall Sharing Conference. The 2022-2023 Educator of the Year will be announced during the Fall Sharing Conference.
